- Be a current member of the USBC through a Bucks County USBC Association certified bowling center; be in good standing and bowling regularly with program. Verified by coach or league official.
- Have a cumulative grade of C+ or GPA of 2.5 or better. Academic achievement is to be verified by school or by a copy of the student's report card.
- Have participated in school and community services or activities.
- Provide references, two (2) are required. They can include the following but cannot include family member;
 - Teacher/Counselor-Academic achievement info may be listed here.
 - Pastor, Employer, Civic group leader, Social Service or Volunteer Managers etc.

Please be aware of the following timeline. <u>No applications will be accepted for consideration if postmarked after the deadline.</u>

- Dec.1st 9Applications are distributed
- April 15th -Application Deadline
- May. 1st Applications will have been scored and ranked.
- May 20th Winners will be determined and all applicants will be notified of their status.
- Jun. 1st Funds will be available for use on or about this date.
