Through experience and determination, we were finally successful in obtaining the 1969 State Bowling Tournament. The Tournament was coordinated by Jack Settelen and was a huge success, attracting record breaking entries in all categories.

In 1980 the L.B.C.M.B.A. decided to bid for the 1983 State Tournament for the second time in its history. The Assoc. selected Ralph Salvati as Tournament Co-coordinator aided by the Proprietors of Bristol Pike Lanes and Jubilee Lanes, the Chamber of Commerce, County Commissioners, Bucks County Historical Tourist Commission and the local hotels, a bid presentation was put together that dominated the 1980 State Convention and swept aside the competing Harrisburg and Lancaster Associations. The eleven-week tournament was again a huge success with team entries totaling 1670. The 1995 State Tournament was decided in 1992 when Lower Bucks went unopposed in its bid. The 1995 Tournament Bid committee headed by Bob Schnepp, Coordinator and Andy Pap and Jim Hennigan, Asst. Coordinators had the support of the management of Bristol Pike & Penndel Lanes, Chamber of Commerce, Bucks County Tourist Commission and all of Lower Bucks Bowling Community. The Bucks County B.A. welcomed 1724 Teams to the 1995 State Tournament with the dedication and services the Bucks County & Pennsylvania State bowlers have come to expect.

In 2005, Bucks Country again hosted a State Tournament. The PSBA State Mixed Tournament bid was awarded to us with the help of Dave Jackson, head of the Bucks County Visitors Center. The tournament was hosted by Bristol Pike Lanes and with the support of the staff at Bristol Pike, the bowlers from Bucks County and the local Bowling Associations a successful tournament was once again held here.
