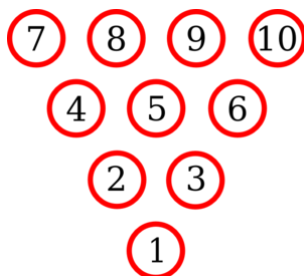

Award changes.

No local adult awards can be earned until a bowler has completed 21 games for the current season. We are no longer using book average to qualify for awards until a current season average is established. Youth bowlers will qualify after 12 games. If you are using BLS, you will need to make that change in your special achievement rules and your award setup. The only exceptions are non average based awards. 750 series, 275 and 700 for women.

This does not apply to USBC 300 games and 800 series.

League Dues

Adult Membership is \$25.

Local Only Membership is \$10

Senior League Only Membership is \$16

Youth memberships are paid by your Association

Membership Card Information:

- Please include the bowler ID number when submitting membership cards. This prevents bowlers from ending up with 2 or more ID numbers. If USBC assigned a new number, it's because they had multiple ID's and they merged them into a new one.
- All memberships are required to have an accurate date of birth on their profile or they will not be able to be processed.

Ensuring accurate dates of birth is essential for compliance with SafeSport and USOPC mandates regarding adult/youth leagues and youth/adult interactions.

- ✓ **Completed League Application:** Signed by the President with the Bonding amount and lane condition indicated.
- ✓ **League dues work sheet:** Please make sure the number of cards sent in is the same number indicated on the work sheet. A check for the full amount for the number of certifications sent in. No information will be entered without payment.
- ✓ **Adult Membership Cards:** Filled out with bowler ID numbers and birthdays separated by membership choice.
- ✓ **Youth Membership cards:** Please have parents fill out the youth cards.
- ✓ **Checks:** Have bowlers make checks out to your league account and write one check to BCUSBC.
- ✓ **End of Year:** All average information (games, total pins, average) must be filled out on the worksheet and sent in by July 1. Averages not submitted will not be able to be verified in case of awards and or tournaments.

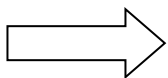

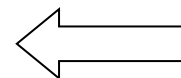

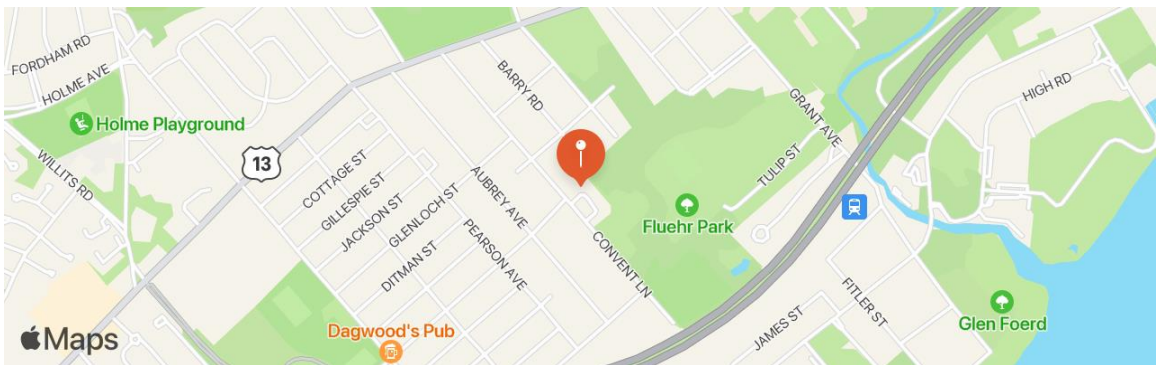
