

Award changes.

No local adult awards can be earned until a bowler has completed 21 games for the current season. We are no longer using book average to qualify for awards until a current season average is established. Youth bowlers will qualify after 12 games. If you are using BLS, you will need to make that change in your special achievement rules and your award setup. The only exceptions are non average based awards. 750 series, 275 and 700 for women.

This does not apply to USBC 300 games and 800 series.

Membership Card Information:

- Please include the <u>bowler ID number</u> when submitting membership cards. This prevents bowlers from ending up with 2 or more ID numbers. If USBC assigned a new number, it's because they had multiple ID's and they merged them into a new one.


