- ☐ Be a High School Senior as of August 1st of the current school year.
- ☐ Must not have been previously awarded a scholarship through this program.
- ☐ Apply through proper channels in accordance with the published time frame.
- ☐ Be a current member of the USBC through a Bucks County USBC Association certified bowling center; be in good standing and bowling regularly with program. Verified by coach or league official.
- ☐ Have a cumulative grade of C+ or GPA of 2.5 or better. Academic achievement is to be provided by including a copy of the student's second marking period report card.
- ☐ Have participated in school and community services or activities.
- ☐ Provide at least two (2) references. They can include the following but cannot include family member.
 - Teacher/Counselor-Academic achievement info may be listed here.
 - Pastor, Employer, Civic group leader, Social Service or Volunteer Managers etc.

Please be aware of the following timeline. No applications will be accepted for consideration if postmarked after the deadline.

- Feb. 1st - Applications are distributed.
- April 11th - Application Deadline
- May 15th - Winners will be determined and all applicants will be notified of their status.
- Jun. 1st - Funds will be available for use on or about this date.

Please note: All funds, after being awarded, will be sent to the USBC Smart Program, and shall be administered by them under their guidelines. They will be in contact with the winners with information on how to obtain the funds.
