## 19<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL WOMENS' CHAMPIONSHIP 2026 RULES

1. The tournament shall consist of a four-woman team event, a doubles event. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event. Total pins with handicap shall decide the winner. The All-Events total will be calculated from your first team and first doubles event plus hdcp.  
**USBC Association, a \$10.00 local membership fee will be charged.**
2. Bowlers shall use their highest 21 game average based on the following order:
  - a. 24/25 Winter Season, if none, then
  - b. 24/25 Summer Season, if none, then
  - c. 25/26 Current Avg with Standing sheet, Min 21 games
  - d. Sport Averages will be converted to standard. Min. 21 games
  - e. No avg, bowlers bowl Scratch 180
  - f. **10 pin rule does apply.**
3. Tournament will be handicapped. NO negative handicap will be assigned. 10 Pin rule does apply. USBC Rule 319A-2 regarding 10 pin increase in average will apply. USBC rules 319d and 319e will not apply.
4. Entrants may bowl with a maximum of three (3) teams. Teams must change 2 bowlers to compete on more than one team. Entrants may enter Doubles with a maximum of two (2) teams. Doubles teams must change 1 bowler to compete on more than one team. Entrant's first team score and first doubles score shall be used to determine the All Events total. **The scores from the First team event ONLY; will count towards no bowl singles.**
5. Substitutes are allowed when replacement is necessary. The Tournament Director must be notified of substitutions at least one hour before scheduled bowling time. In case of an emergency, after a game has started, a substitute, if one is available, shall be allowed in the team and doubles events only. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frame(s) bowled shall count. A substitute shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid.
6. **THE LINE-UP WILL BE THE SAME AS SUBMITTED ON THE ENTRY FORM.** Entries will be scheduled according to request, IF POSSIBLE. The schedule will not be changed by the tournament director except for an emergency. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director for each event. Each event will be bowled on a pair of lanes. If needed, squads will be consolidated, based on the number of entries received.
7. **ANY PLAYER OR TEAM ARRIVING AFTER THE GAME HAS STARTED WILL BE ALLOWED TO BOWL AND THE SCORES WILL COUNT BEGINNING IN THE FRAME THEN BEING BOWLED. A SCORE OF 0 (ZERO) WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.**
8. In the team event, the captain checks in the entire team **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled bowling time. All bowlers in the doubles event must check in with the tournament **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled bowling time.
9. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed **IN WRITING** to the tournament director before the tournament prize payments are made. Errors in scoring must be reported to tournament officials within 24 hours.
10. First place ties in any event will be declared co-champions, with first and second place money divided equally, and duplicate trophies awarded.
11. Prize money paid into each event will be returned to the winners at that event only. Prizes will be paid with at least one prize for each six (6) entries (according to entries in each class).
12. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area, except for medical reasons. **Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the playing area.**
13. Official scorers will be furnished by BCUSBC. If an official scorer is not available, the tournament official will authorize a team captain or representative to record their own scores.
14. **Any rules or regulations concerning the conduct of this tournament not specified herein shall be governed by the rules of the United States Bowling Congress.**
15. **POSITIVELY NO DELAYS OR POSTPONEMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. LATE BOWLERS WILL START IN THE FRAME BEING BOWLED. NO MISSED FRAMES MAY BE MADE UP.** The Tournament officials shall allow no unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Bowlers must notify a tournament official if they must leave the playing area. In the event of a machine breakdown, another pair of lanes will be assigned, if available. If a member or team refuses to proceed after being directed to do so, the game or series shall be declared forfeited.
16. Only ONE ball per bowler shall be permitted on the rack for each event. In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane. This rule shall apply to doubles and singles events also.
17. All bowlers are responsible for having their applications properly completed to reflect their entry into the events they want. Tournament officials are not responsible for incomplete or improperly filled out applications.
18. All bowlers should verify their entries prior to bowling. **Once the bowler throws their first ball of the tournament, their application is final.**
19. Returned checks may be subject to a returned check fee of up to \$35.00.
20. **No squad blocking allowed.**
